- **Principal's Update (Debra):**
 - Initial camp information went out in newsletter
 - Cost between \$130 and \$150
 - Mr. Cantlon will be going to WSU beginning of March to finalize details
 - Play – Tom Sawyer – will be the week of February 20th, with evening performance on Feb 27th
 - 5/6th Band concert will be March 1st
 - Strings ensemble competition – students did well
 - Language immersion will be coming to Libby next fall
 - ~40students have already signed up
 - Student safety concerns
 - a meeting was held at Libby regarding safety and busses. Proposing to move bus pick/up/dropoff behind the building, and move parent pickup/dropoff on the cafeteria side of the building and north side of the building. A parent survey will be sent out to get feedback on routes that parents drive to pickup/dropoff students
- **Citizens Advisory Committee Update (Shawna):**
 - Reported on past two meetings
 - Vacancy on the Board
 - Mumps outbreak – most cases were already immunized
 - Language immersion
 - Considering a capital levy to replace the current levy in order to be able to move money around a little easier (vs. bond) – needs 50% to pass
 - Free and reduced lunch in SPS is currently 56% - Senate wants to update using old census data
 - Suicide prevention (2 kids/week in WA state commit suicide) – looking into some sort of parent support – Most schools have a mental health therapist (Libby does not, but Glenda and Debra have been working on this for a while)
 - Talk to your kids about it!
 - Technology study – polled students about what are their technology stressors.
 - Long-range planning
