How are art projects graded? How are art grades for report cards determined? Starting this year, we will be switching to a new system of grading. Each project will earn a letter grade (A,B,C, etc). Project grades will be averaged for quarter and semester grades.

Projects will be assessed in the following areas:

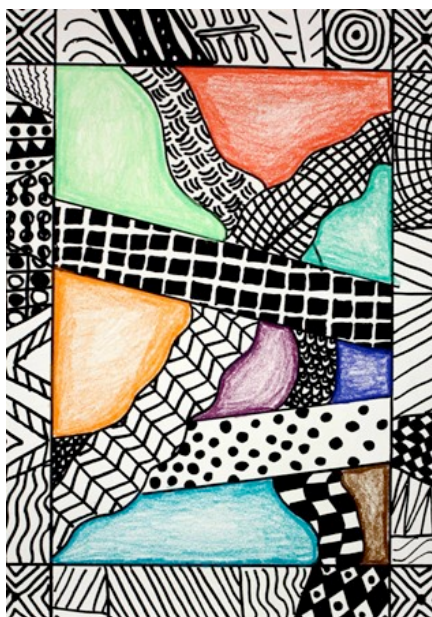
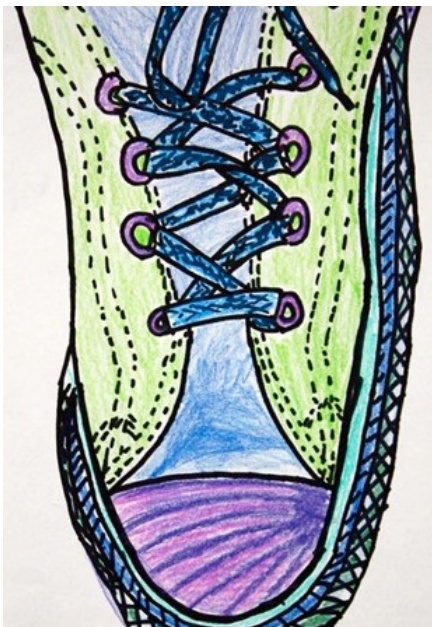
**ART CONCEPTS** – 25% of grade (1 pt)  
Displays a mastery of the Art Elements, Principles of Design and other art areas built into the art project.

**CRAFTSMANSHIP** – 25% of grade (1 pt)  
Student spent required time on art project. Demonstrates use of tools, skills and processes skillfully.

**FULL COMPLETION OF ASSIGNMENT** – 25% of grade (1 pt)  
Demonstrates good work habits in completing work on time.

**ATTITUDE AND EFFORT** – 25 % of grade (1 pt)  
Conversation and behavior focused on art task, student works to the best of their ability. Student put in genuine effort and wasted no class time.

- B= 3 out of 4 areas met
- C= 2 out of 4 areas met
- D= 1 out of 4 areas met
- F= 0 out of 4 areas met

Over 3,270 visitors have viewed our Artsonia art gallery page since we started posting artwork in December of 2012. ## ART HOMEWORK

A student may work at a different pace or miss an art class due to an illness. Sometimes, a student needs extra time to finish up an art project. If a student needs extra time to work on completing an assignments, they can make arrangements with their art teacher. Some art materials can be checked out to finish the assignment as homework. Materials are checked out for a 7 day period, and need to be returned to the art room within a week.



Students who miss art, on a regular basis, have a difficult time catching up on their assignments. Not only do they miss demonstrations on art techniques, but they miss time to work on their projects. With only an hour of art per week, regular attendance is important!
