

CHECK THIS OUT ⇒ First, Mt. Spokane wants to introduce more kids and parents to the sports of skiing and snowboarding, and has made the Odyssey and Tessera families a truly spectacular offer. If you have ever thought about learning how to ski/board, but the price of doing so has put you off, then this offer is for you: Any novice student, parent, family member, relative, or friend can receive 3 Friday nights of skiing in February (two of which are our Ski Mob nights), 3 1½ hour lessons from Mt Spokane's ski school, 3 night's of equipment rentals, AND a big piece of pizza and a drink on each night (so the kids can eat with their Ski Mob classmates) for a total of \$80! Further, after your three nights of lessons, Mt Spokane will offer you a season pass for the rest of this season and ALL OF NEXT SEASON for only \$90! Mt. Spokane has asked me to make it clear that this deal is for "newbie's" only. They want people who have never skied/boarded before, or those who tried it once or twice sometime ago but never really learned how. If you have learned how to ski/board, can get on and off chairlifts without help, and are ready to perfect your skills on intermediate or "blue square" runs, this offer is not for you. If you like this offer, call or email me so that I can get you in touch with the right people at the mountain. If you choose to do this on February 7th, 14th, and 21st then your kids can ski and play with their Ski Mob classmates on the first and third of your three nights.

Second, driving to Mt Spokane takes almost exactly 50 minutes from Libby. You will park at Lodge 2 (not Lodge 1). If you are using a 5th Grade Ski Passport, go inside to the Snow Sport Center and get your tickets and rentals. If you are NOT using the 5th Grade Ski Passport (or have no clue what that is) go up the stairs on the right side of the lodge and look for the tables reserved for Odyssey. I will have your tickets and vouchers. Mt. Spokane closes at 9:30 PM, so most kids will be getting home late.

Third, Mt. Spokane is once again offering us some special prices: A lift ticket for skiing or boarding, a big piece of pizza, a drink, and the sales taxes for all three will cost you \$25 even (\$5 if you don't need a lift ticket). Mt. Spokane will rent skis/boards, boots and poles for another \$20.00 even, including sales tax. The rental agreement requires the signature of a parent or guardian - no exceptions. Therefore, if your student needs to rent equipment and is traveling without you, you must send him/her with a signed agreement. Copies of the rental agreement are available at the school office or at mtspokane.com.

Fourth, the mountain wants me to be cashier for the costs of tickets, rentals, and lessons. When you arrive, go immediately to the cafeteria area in Lodge 2 and look for the tables reserved for Odyssey between the kitchen and the restrooms. I or another parent will be there to take your money and give you tickets and vouchers. Please come with the correct cash or a check payable to "Mt. Spokane". If you must use a credit card, you will need to wait in the ticket line downstairs.

Fifth, once again MT SPOKANE WILL CONTRIBUTE 10% OF THE NIGHT'S PROCEEDS FROM OUR GROUP TO OUR PTG!!!

Sixth, quite a few students will go without their parents. If your kids need a ride, please try to arrange a carpool with the other parents. If you need help finding another parent with room in their car, let me know. If they are riding with another family, please send them to school that day with their clothing and gear. Mr. Lemmon will keep their gear locked in the exercise room until school closes.

Sixth, I need to know approximately how many will be coming by Thursday the 6th. If your kids will go, please complete this information and have your student take it to the school office. If you can't get it to the office, please contact me by phone or email.
